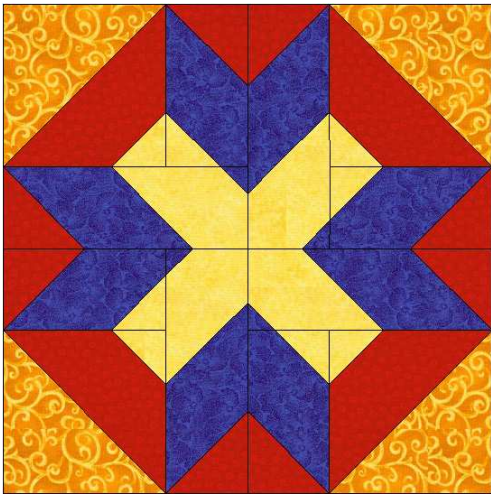


Freedom Star Block #15

Crossed Star Block



12" x 12" Finished

This Crossed Star Block is made up of four fabrics. Be sure to have a strong contrast between your cross fabric and star fabric so that the cross stands out! I have shown this block in the Freedom Star Blocks colors of red, gold/ white and blue you of course, can choose to make up this block in your favorite colors.

You will have to print out the paper-pieced PDF Pattern and make a total of four copies.

To help with color placement:

A1 – background fabric #1 (dark gold)

A2 - background fabric #2 (red)

A3 – cross fabric (light gold/white)

B1 – background fabric #2 (red)

B2 – star fabric (blue)

B3 – cross fabric (light gold)

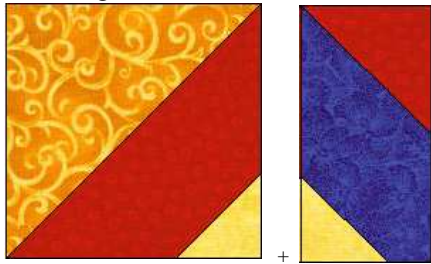
C1 – background fabric #2 (red)

C2 – star fabric (blue)

C3 – cross fabric (light gold/white)

C4 – star fabric (blue)

Stitch out four of each section A, B and C. Use the color diagram for fabric placement. First sew each set of the four sections A & B together. Then sew sections C to the AB sections for a total of four A-B-C units. For all sections, be sure to match the points carefully. It helps sometimes to stay stitch in a longer stitch length over the matching points. Then go back and sew over entire seam, stitching with a shorter stitch.



Combine all four A -B-C units to make the completed Crossed Star Block.
