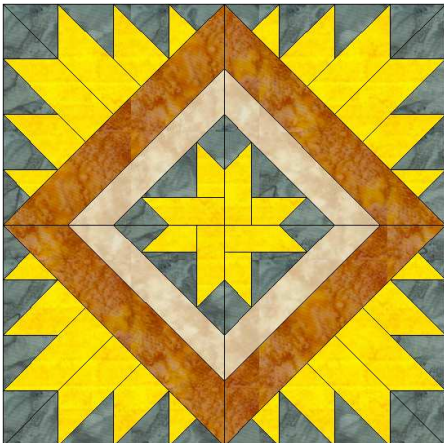


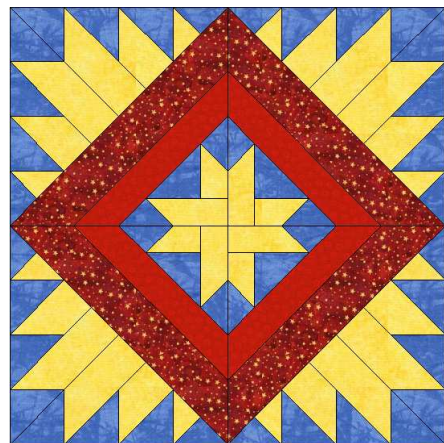

Manhattan Star Block
Freedom Stars Colors

12" x 12" Finished

The Manhattan Star Block is made up of four fabrics. Be sure to choose a bright fabric for your star and points.

I have shown this block in two color ways, first in Art Deco colors with a gold star and star points, 2 shades of brown for the contrast strips and dark silver for the background. The second version is in the Freedom Star colors, with a gold star and star points, 2 shades of red for the contrast strips and blue for the background.

You will have to print out the paper-pieced PDF Pattern and make a total of four copies.

To help with color placement:

Section A

A1, A3, A5 and A7 - background color

A2, A4 and A6 - star points color

Section B

B1, B3, B5 and B7 - background color

B2, B4 and B6 -star points color.

Section C

C1, C3 and C5 - background color

C2 and C4 – star color

C6 – first contrast strip color

C7 – second contrast strip color

Stitch out four of each section A, B and C.

Notice that the PDF files are printed as mirror images of the sections....so your finished pieces when sewn out should look exactly like the picture below.

Use the color diagram for fabric placement.

First sew each set of the four sections A & B together.

Then sew sections C to the AB sections for a total of four A-B-C units.

Combine all four A –B-C units to make the completed Manhattan Star Block.
