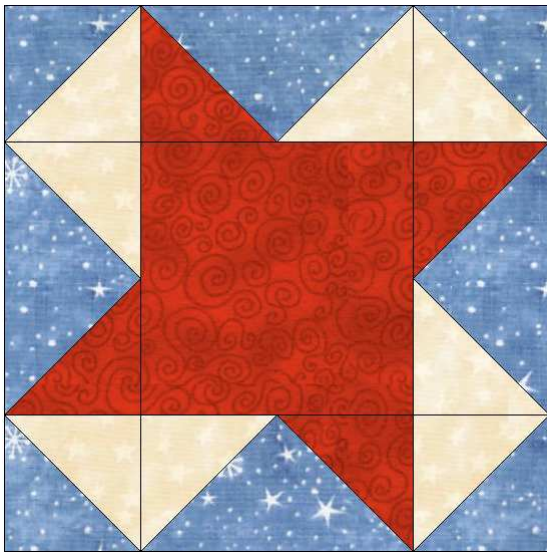

## Fourth of July Star Block



Fourth of July Star Block

12" x 12" Finished

This simple block is made up of three fabrics and simple quilting shapes. It reminds me of the spinners that we put out for the Fourth of July Celebration. Use red (or a stripe) for the center block and one half of the flying geese unit, white for the second half of the flying geese unit and medium blue for the background.

Step one - Cut a 6 1/2" square from the red (stripe) for the center of the block.

Step two – Flying Geese units

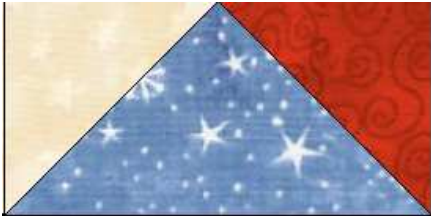
If you need help, download the PDF file for making Flying Geese units.

Cut four blue rectangles 3 ½” x 6 ½”

Cut four white squares 3 ½” x 3 ½”

Cut four red (stripe) squares 3 ½” x 3 ½”

Make four Flying Geese units each with one end from white fabric and other end from red (stripe) fabric as shown below.



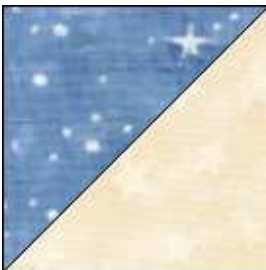
Step three – Half-Square Triangle units

If you need help, download the PDF file for Half-Square Triangle units.

Cut 2 white squares 4” x 4”

Cur 2 blue squares 4” x 4”

Make four Half-Square Triangle units....trim to finish at 3 ½” square.



To Finish-

Combine all of the units – as you would for a nine-patch block – to complete the star.
